St Luke's Community Hall

History

St. Luke's Community Hall was built in 1877 to serve as a meeting place for working men from the surrounding community. For many years it was maintained by St. Luke's Church, and was virtually rebuilt in the early 1980s. More recently its charitable status was reviewed and in 2003 it was formally reconstituted as a community hall under a new Management Committee so that it could continue to be a useful resource, providing a venue for *"meetings, lectures and classes, and other forms of recreation and leisure time activities with the object of improving the conditions of life for the inhabitants of the borough"*.

The Committee hopes that it will continue to be well used and appreciated by the community for many years to come.

- **Adjoining kitchen with double oven, dishwasher, gas hob, fridge, microwave and serving hatch**
- **Male & female toilets, and disabled person's toilet**
- **Part hardwood parquet block floor, ideal for dancing**
- **Upright piano**
- **Free use of tables & chairs**
- **Disabled access ramp to main door**
- **Parking for up to six cars by rear door for drop-off and collection**
- **Full central heating**

Parking

The roads around the Hall are a resident's parking zone from 10:00am to 4:00pm on Monday—Friday, but free spaces are usually available at evenings and weekends.

The multi-storey car park adjacent to Sainsbury's is 0.3 miles (6 minutes walk) away.

There are parking spaces for up to six cars behind the hall (entry from St Luke's Road), with adjacent double door access that can be used for dropping off and collection by hirers.

When parking on-street, please avoid blocking access to the driveways of our neighbours.

Location

The Hall is situated just north of Maidenhead Town Centre, on the corner of St. Luke's Road and Norfolk Road.
